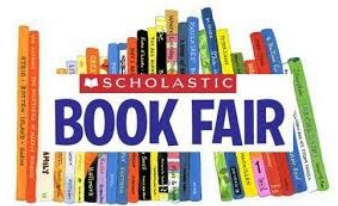

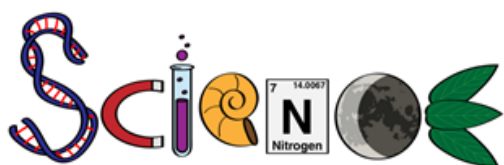
## **\*\*CHANGE IN DATE\*\* - Wear a Bright Colour to School Day!**
